

Basic Instructions to Join ChatGPT and Some Prompts to Use

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How to Join ChatGPT

- **1. Sign Up:** First things first, head over to https://chat.openai.com/ and create an account. Choose a suitable plan for your needs they offer both free and paid options.
- **2. Understand the Basics:** Spend some time getting to know what ChatGPT is and how it works. Remember, it's a language model, which means it generates text based on the input you give it. The more precise your instructions, the better the output.

- **3. Get Comfortable with the Chat Interface:** ChatGPT operates on a simple text interface. All you have to do is enter your instructions (these are called *prompts*), and ChatGPT will provide a text output. Start by using short, clear prompts and gradually try more complex instructions as you learn what works best for you.
- **4. Start with our Sample Prompts:** Start with the simple prompts we have included on the next page.

Some Prompts to Use

1. Making revision notes from a handout or resource

Please use headings and bullet points as well as short sentences. Please include any references you find.

2. Understanding criteria

Here is the criteria we used:

Outcome 1 - Work within a user-centred agreement for the counselling work

Criteria 1.1 - Enable clients to explore their attitudes to and expectations of counselling within specific agency settings.
